#### About the Department

#### Programs Offered

#### • M.A. in English

A two-year master's program is designed to foster students' interest in Literature, Language, and research. This program offers unique opportunities for students through courses such as History of English Literature, Literary Theory and Criticism, English Language Teaching, Comparative Literature, Linguistics, Colonial and Post-Colonial Studies, Film Studies, Research Project, Translation Studies, Indian Writings, and Women's Writing.

• The department of English will offer one year M.A. and two year M.A. courses starting from academic year 2026-27 as per NEP 2020.

#### Eligibility:

Students who have completed their Bachelor of Arts in English from any recognised university with a minimum of 45 per cent are eligible to apply for this programme.

#### Ph.D. in English and ELT

The PhD programme will have a minimum duration of three years, including coursework, and a maximum duration of six (6) years from the date of admission to the programme.









## Online Cultural Exchange Programme
